
I am an organic mung bean farmer. Because of my organic operation, I harvest the beans in a special way to reduce bean breakage. I cut my beans with an 18' windrower and combine them with an old pull type, rubber cylinder combine. I was in the market for a "new" combine and located an Allies chalmers All crop Model 60, outside St. Louis, Missouri. This combine has bronze wheel bushings.

I decided the best way to get it home, to Orienta, Oklahoma, was to pull it (500 miles). The farmer I bought the combine from was going to grease the wheels with a conventional grease before I started home. I said "No, I'm going to use a special grease, Thixogrease.

I put a couple of squirts of Thixogrease on the wheels and drove 30 minutes to Interstate 44. I stopped and checked the hubs. They were too hot to touch. I put in some more Thixogrease. I repeated this process every 15 to 30 minutes, slowly forcing the old grease out. When I got to Joplin, Missouri, the hubs were warm to the touch. I spent the night there. The next morning, I finished greasing with Thixogrease and continued home at 55 miles per hour. The hubs stayed cool all the way.
